History

The name was left unchanged to preserve continuity with our customers.

We've been in the same location, on East Main Street in Chattanooga, TN, since 1914, and family owned until 1978. Chattanooga Boiler & Tank is now a subsidiary of Williams Enterprises of Georgia (WEOGA). WEOGA is strategically located in Atlanta GA. They are a holding company that consists of various steel fabrication and erection companies. They include Chattanooga Boiler & Tank Co., Atlanta Steel Erectors, Williams Erection, Industrial Fabricators Inc., and Carolina Integrated Solutions.

We fabricate and erect some very complex structures in various regions of the country. You can travel to almost every state in our country and point to some steel process vessel or custom designed steel structure that we have fabricated and erected throughout our history. We have drawings on our walls of tanks that CB&T built in Havana, Cuba in 1920!

Focus

While we regularly fabricate and erect for most major industries our primary markets over the years have included the Power, Chemical and Pulp and Paper Industries. Our main emphasis is on field erected tanks, silos and pressure vessels constructed of stainless steel, carbon steel and exotic alloys. We also specialize in larger, more complex shop built items from the same materials.

Throughout our company's history, Chattanooga has kept pace with the latest technology in the fabrication business and we are certified to ASME VIII, API and AWWA codes as well as being AISC Certified.

Our 114 years of fabrication experience helps us to provide a cost effective and wise investment to our customers.

Operations & Capabilities

Our custom design, fabrication and erection capabilities are second to none. The more complex the project the brighter we shine. We have the ability to form and weld plate materials in excess of 2" thick with materials such as stainless steel, various alloys, aluminum and carbon steel. We also fabricate AISC certified steel structures made of stainless on a custom basis.

This division of our company has performed extensive repair to scrubbers, coal silos, pressure vessels and tanks throughout the country. These very aggressive and demanding outage related projects are one of the many ways we excel.
